As one remarked, I didn't lose my virginity any more than I lost my pacifier. I outgrew it. The very moment of losing virginity among same sex couples can be a gray area and a topic of debate. In one sense, losing one's virginity is an antiquated concept, because society no longer regards sex outside of marriage as shameful.
